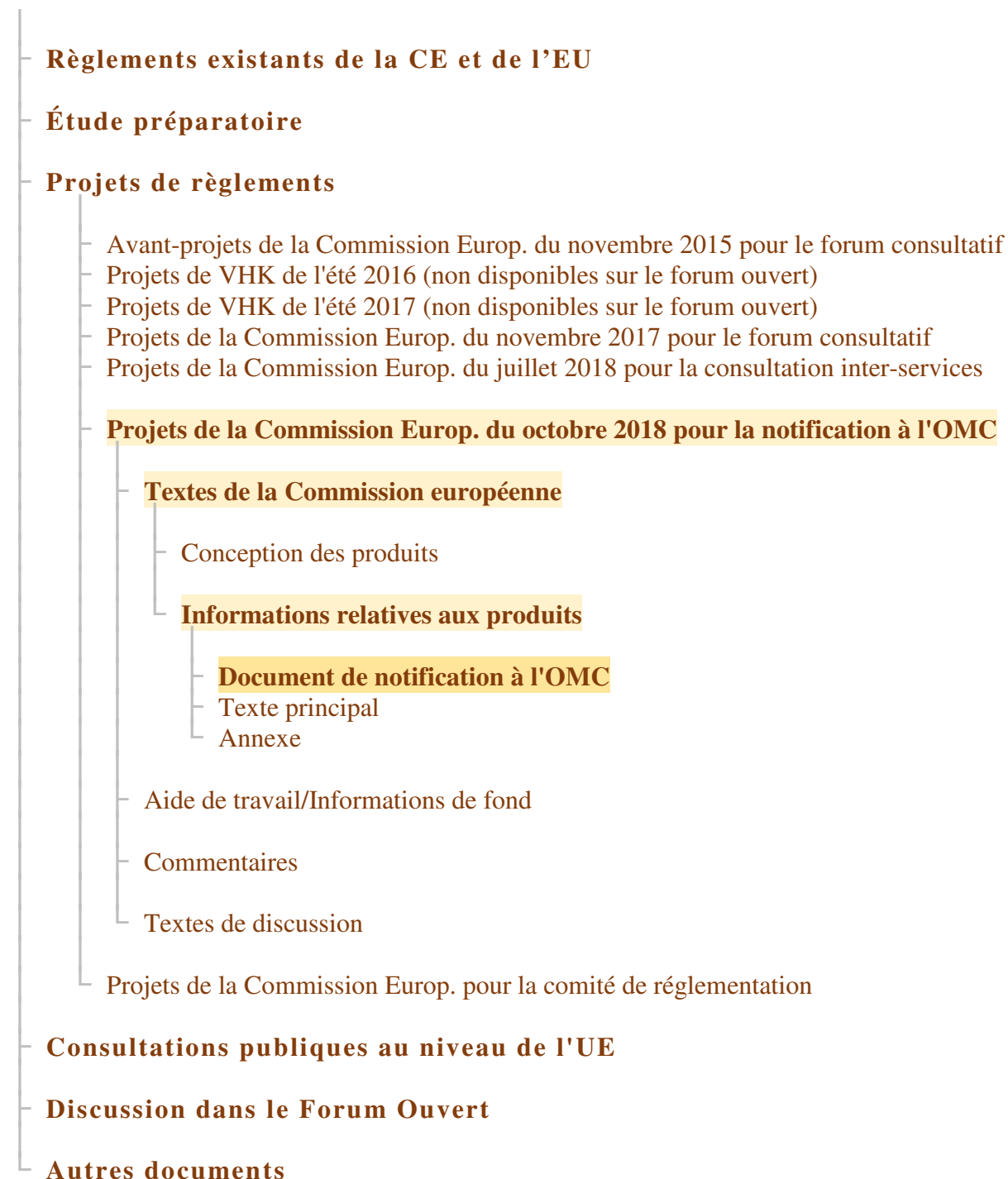

Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Draft Commission Regulation laying down ecodesign requirements for light sources and separate control gears pursuant to Directive 2009/125/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Commission Regulations (EC) No 244/2009, (EC) No 245/2009 and (EU) No 1194/2012 (10 pages + Annexes 25 pages, in English).
6. Description of content: This draft Commission Regulation sets minimum energy performance, functional and information requirements for lighting products, as there exists a cost-effective potential to limit their energy consumption and improve their quality. In accordance with Ecodesign Directive 2009/125/EC, products not meeting these requirements will not be allowed to be placed on the EU market. The draft Regulation is based on the findings of two technical, environmental and economic studies, which have been carried out with stakeholders. The draft Regulation repeals: (i) Regulation (EC) No 244/2009 with regard to ecodesign requirements for non-directional household lamps; (ii) Regulation (EC) No 245/2009 with regard to ecodesign requirements for fluorescent lamps without integrated ballast, for high intensity discharge lamps, and for ballasts and luminaires able to operate such lamps; and (iii) Regulation (EU) No 1194/2012 with regard to ecodesign requirements for directional lamps, light emitting diode lamps and related equipment.
7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: The aim is to continue to remove the worst performing lighting products from the market, thereby pushing the market towards more environmentally friendly products. It will increase energy efficiency and contribute to the fight against climate change.

Proposed date of entry into force: 20 days from publication in the Official Journal of the EU. The provisions shall start applying from September 2021.
