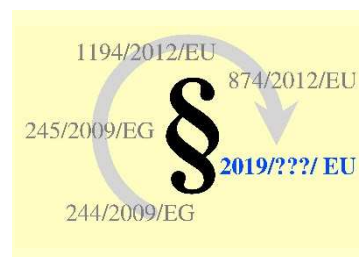

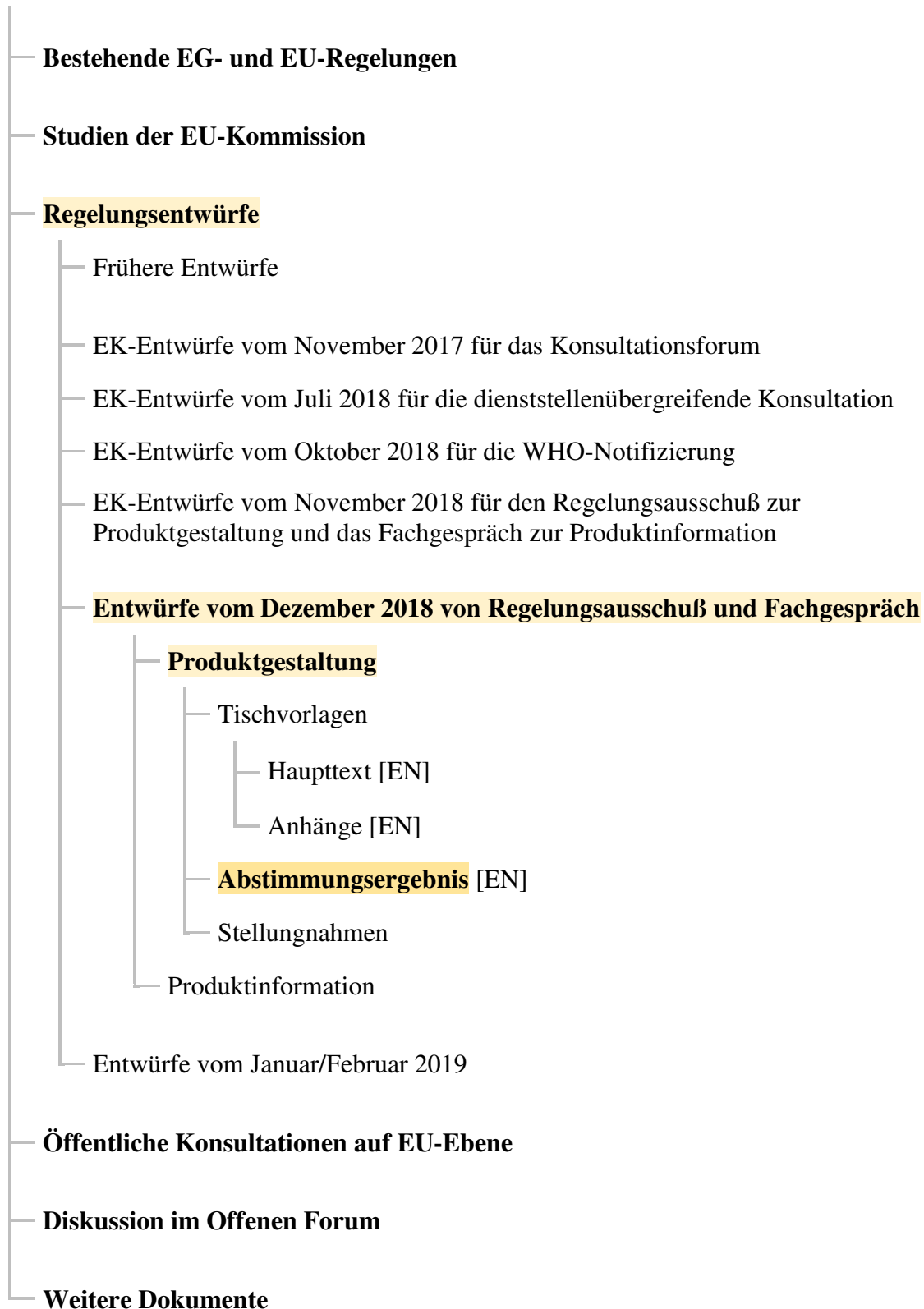

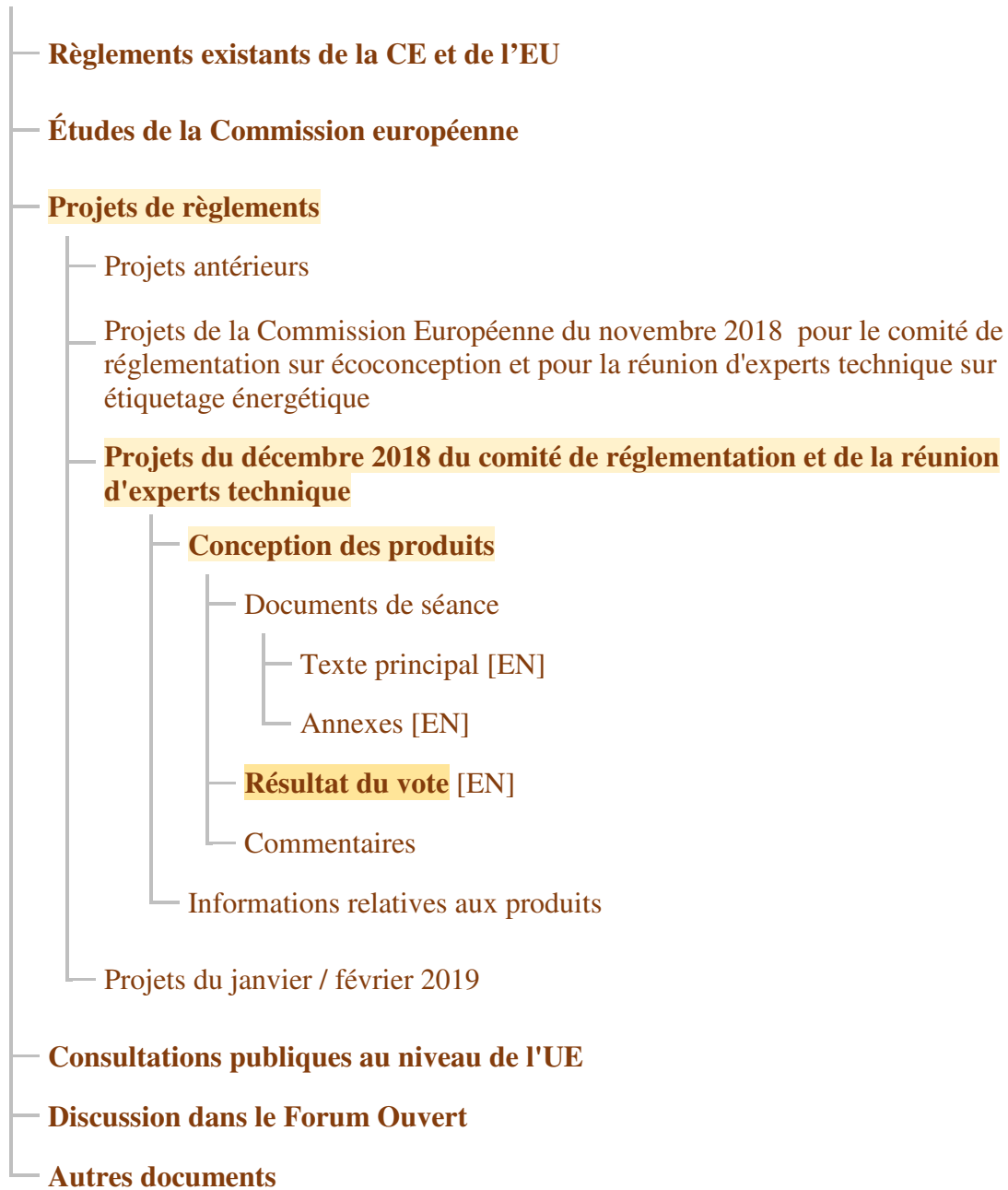

¹ The regulatory procedure with scrutiny still applies in cases in which the basic act has not yet been aligned to the Lisbon Treaty

² In accordance with Article 16(4) TEU a **qualified majority** is defined as at least 55% of the Member States (ie. 16) comprising at least 65% of the EU population. A blocking minority must include at least four Member States, failing which the qualified majority shall be deemed attained.
